SOCIAL AND EMOTIONAL LEARNING KITS

K – 3 SEL Kit #6: Let's Read and Write

Why This is Important: Books are filled with emotions and we, as readers, feel for the characters and their experiences. Reading and writing are great ways to offer a gateway to learning about social emotional skills.



Activity 1: Drawing Our Emotions



Grade Level: Kindergarten – Second Grade

Duration: 10 – 15 minutes

Materials: Dry Erase Board, Markers, Books

Tasks:

- Use the dry erase board and the dry erase markers that are provided.
- Have the students draw a picture to demonstrate how the book makes them feel.
- Discuss how books can make you have different feelings (peaceful, happy, sad, etc).
- Teachers may wish to provide students with a visual emotions chart to help guide discussion https://www.happierhuman.com/feelings-charts-kids/
- Teachers may choose a book from the kit to have students read and describe how the book makes them feel at different points throughout the story.
- Encourage students to describe what triggered their emotions in the books.

Activity 2: Reading Our Emotions



Grade Level: Kindergarten - Second Grade

Duration: 10 – 15 minutes

Materials: Books and Hear Myself Phone

Tasks:

- Using the Hear Myself Phone the student will read a book from the kit to themself.
- After they read the book, the student can use the Hear Myself Phone to identify what they liked or did
 not like from the book and identify personal qualities that they share with the character from the book.

Activity 3: Sharing Our Feelings



Grade Level: Kindergarten – Second Grade

Duration: 10 – 15 minutes

Materials: Books and Silly Sentence Starters

Tasks:

 Have the student read a book from the kit and utilize the Silly Sentence Starter to discuss the relationship amount what one character says/does and how it makes another character feel (e.g., sharing tattling, helping, etc).

Activity 4: Writing Our Feelings



Grade Level: Kindergarten – Second Grade

Duration: 10 – 15 minutes

Materials: Dry Erase Board, Markers, Books and Creative Thinking Flip Chart

Tasks:

- Have the student read a book from the kit and utilize the Creative Thinking Flip Chart to identify their likes and dislikes of the book by drawing or writing them.
- Students can share with each other.
